

Motion to Reinstate Proceeding Following Dismissal

Instructions: A plaintiff may file a motion to reinstate a case following a dismissal no later than 14 days after the order of dismissal was signed. The plaintiff must serve the defendant with a copy of the motion no later than the next business day. For good cause, the court may reinstate the case. If the judge has not ruled, the motion is denied at 5:00 p.m. on the 21st day after the date the order of dismissal was signed. **Rule 505.3**
